Walking & Biking Dog Friendly Trails



Grand Lake Metropolitan Recreation District has developed scenic mountain biking and hiking trails on the recreation district land. Single track trails through fun and exciting terrain, with vistas of the three lakes, Colorado River, and wetlands with wild flowers. We have wildlife - *BEWARE OF WILDLIFE*.

Phase I: NOW OPEN! Developed by local mountain bike riders and hikers. Ten miles of trails are open, including a 5 mile round trip to the Colorado River, the "Short & Scenic" trail is a 0.5 mile loop, with easy access from the parking lot. Two viewing areas with picnic tables are in place.

Phase II and III: Working to add to & enhance the network of trails – 10 miles have been built. New trails and signage are in progress. As trails develop, additional viewing areas with picnic tables & log stumps will be created.

TRAILHEAD/PARKING:

Take U.S. Hwy 34 North toward Rocky Mountain National Park and Grand Lake. Go past the entrance to the town of Grand Lake, approx. 1/4 mile, turn left on County Road 48. The trailhead is 1 mile on the left.
